





Mrs. Davidson's Classroom

Our school year is off to a great start! This week our schedule was more normal and we are getting into our regular routine. Our Bible unit is on Salvation and we have been opening gifts each day that represent wonderful things God has given to us. So far we have opened gifts for the world, the freedom of choice, Jesus' sacrifice to make up for our wrong choices, and the cleansing power of God's forgiveness.

In Social Studies we are learning about the Midwest Region of the United States. This week we did a scavenger hunt and learned interesting facts about the states in the midwest, and learned about Ohio and Indiana.

The students are doing different things in math. The first grade has focused on writing and modeling addition and subtraction; the second grade has been working with equal groups and repeated addition; and third-grade math has learned about reading number lines and thermometers and the fractions of an hour.

We are also working hard on writing skills and this week worked on descriptive writing and starting sentences with capital letters. The students have started working on their typing skills, as well. There has been lots of building with bristle blocks, putting together puzzles (especially the puzzle map of the U.S.), making designs with pattern blocks, and various other games. The 4th through 7th grade students have been learning about the War in Heaven and God's wonderful love for us, His protection over us and His willingness to die for us so that we could be forgiven of our sins. They have been very engaged in it and have learned their memory verses well.
